This cradle is designed to be used with a variety of Gamber-Johnson mounting systems. Installation instructions for other Gamber-Johnson products are provided with each individual product.

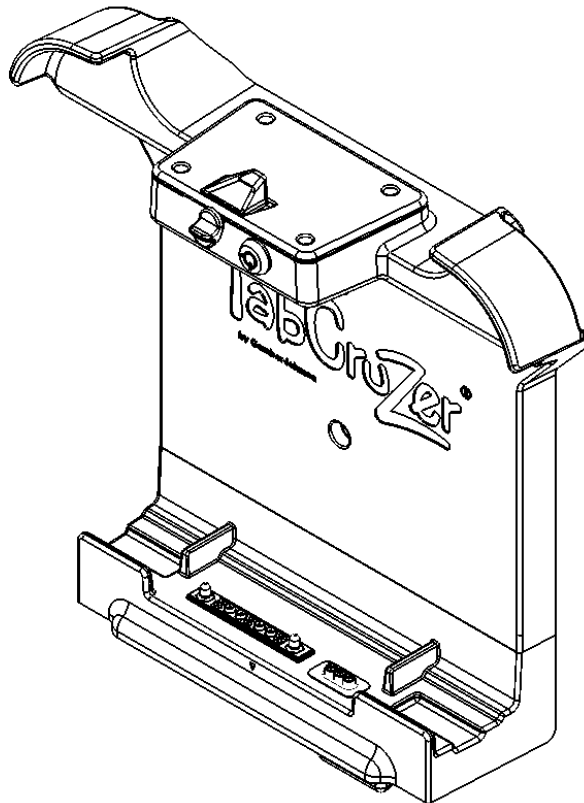

# INSERTING THE COMPUTER INTO THE CRADLE

## INSERTING THE COMPUTER

1. Insert the bottom of the computer into the cradle (the cradle and computer have triangle alignment guides to help with locating the computer correctly). See Figure 1.

Then rotate the top of the computer into the cradle until the latch housing comes through the computer handle opening and the latch springs upward to hold the unit in place. See Figure 2.

2. (Optional) The key lock can now be used for security purposes.

## REMOVING THE COMPUTER

1. Unlock if locked.

2. Push downward on the thumb knob and pull outward on the handle of the computer until it clears the latch housing. Lift the computer out of the dock. See Figure 3.
